

First Nations Arts and Cultures Panel

Meeting communiqué

The seventeenth meeting of the First Nations Arts and Cultures Panel (the Panel) was held on Friday 22 March 2024, 10.00am to 3:15pm with Panel members and Departmental staff.

Meeting summary

At the meeting the Panel:

- paid respects to the Traditional Custodians of the lands and waters upon which meeting participants were located and acknowledged the cultural authority of First Nations persons present
- observed one-minute's silence for all those who are grieving and experiencing sorry business
- endorsed the minutes of the 3 November 2023 meeting and approved the meeting communiqué for publication on the Arts Queensland (AQ) website
- welcomed Mr Dean Gibson, First Nations filmmaker, to the First Nations Arts and Cultures Panel
- noted increased Queensland Government investment through Arts Queensland funding programs over the first two years of the Grow Action Plan 2022-2026 to deliver on the Creative Together priority to elevate First Nations arts
- informed Arts Queensland submissions to national policy discussions and agreed to form a subcommittee to respond to the Australian Government's consultation regarding standalone legislation to protect Indigenous Cultural and Intellectual Property (ICIP)
- noted that AQ is advancing the development of a First Nations fashion and textiles strategy and is exploring opportunities to develop a fashion production hub in Cairns
- set priorities for 2024 including contributions to national policy conversations including Indigenous Cultural and Intellectual Property issues, active engagement with the development of a cultural program framework for Brisbane 2032, informing Arts Queensland strategy development including First Nations fashion and design, arts and disability and creative workforce development
- noted Screen Queensland's development of a First Nations screen strategy
- noted the recent establishment and launch of the Queensland Indigenous Business Network to support First Nations business operators to network and share valuable leanings.
